Generally, a donor may deduct an in-kind (or, non-cash) donation as a charitable contribution.

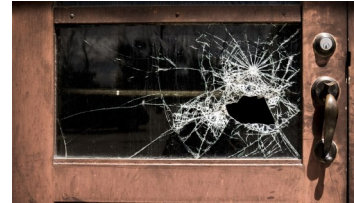
