### April 6, 2019

This annual signature event kicks off a month-long community revitalization effort.

The 2019 event will focus on Phoenix's Estrella Neighborhood in the Isaac School District, where hundreds of volunteers will unite to repair homes and beautify the community.

This year's project is one of our biggest undertakings to date! Plans include building a community park on a 2-acre lot in front of Moya Elementary School; clearing debris from vacant lots located around the school; creating a sustainable community garden on the school grounds; and completing critical repairs on 10 homes in the area.

### **Does it cost to participate?**

Yes. The \$25 registration fee for individuals covers the cost of a t-shirt, food and beverages, and your project supplies and materials.

### **What do I need to bring on National Rebuilding Day?**

A smile. You might also bring a hat, a long-sleeved shirt, or sunscreen if you don't want to stand in line to use ours. You will definitely need closed-toe shoes. We provide personal safety equipment and all the tools for each project.

### **Do I need to bring a lunch?**

No, we will feed you lunch and provide water and snacks throughout the day.

**Can I bring my children?**

No one under 10 is allowed on the job site. Youth between 10 and 18 must be personally supervised by a parent or guardian.

**How do I register?**

**What time do I need to get there? When will we finish?**

We will begin check-in at 7:15 a.m. and ask that everyone arrive by 7:30. We plan to begin work at 8 a.m. sharp. Lunch will be available beginning around 11:30 a.m., and we should wrap up for the day no later than about 2 p.m. If you finish your assigned job before that, you may leave when you need to.
